## Surface Preparation

Surfaces must be clean, dry and free of dirt, grease, oil or water. For a reliable bond we recommend wiping non porous surfaces down with SabreSurface Activator.

## Directions for use

Cut off the end of the sausage and insert into a manual or pneumatic gun. Place the sausage nozzle on top of the sausage, and screw on the cap. Cut back the nozzle to the required size. Apply adhesive to the substrate. Remove masking before skinning.

## Limitations

- Avoid application below +5 °C and above +35 °C
- Do not apply on curing silicones
- Not for aquarium use or full submersion
- Not for structural glazing
- Do not use on surfaces that may bleed oil or plasticizers
- Do not apply on curing silicones
- Will not bond to low surface energy plastics i.e. PE and Teflon
