Uses

Surface Preparation

Ensure all surfaces are clean, dry and free from dirt, grease or loose material. All framing dimensions must comply with NZS 3604:1999. All surfaces must be at least 10°C.

Application

Walls

Apply SabreFix WB in daubs of about 35mm wide by 15 to 25mm high at 300mm centres to intermediate studs. Immediately fix sheet in place. The perimeter must be mechanically fixed.

Ceilings

Work one sheet at a time. Apply SabreFix WB in daubs of about 35mm wide by 15 to 25mm high at 200mm centres except for the perimeter and centre line, which must be screwed. Immediately fix sheet in place.

Note

Ensure full contact between the sheets and SabreFix WB until adhesive sets. The use of temporary direct fix screws through blocks are recommended. SabreFix WB will dry and full is strength is reached in 24 hours to 48 hours.

Storage & Shelf Life

Store in a cool dry place below 25°C and out of direct sunlight. Do not freeze. Shelf life is 24 months for cartridges and 12 months for sausages from the date of manufacture when stored as directed.

Cleaning

Clean up with water before adhesive cures.

Limitations

- SabreFix WB stud adhesive must be used in conjunction with nails or screws.
- Do not apply adhesive around sheet edges, or under fasteners.
- Do not nail or screw through the adhesive.
- Do not fix nails or screws closer than 200mm to adhesive.
- Do not fix more than one sheet at a time to avoid skinning of the adhesive, which may result in adhesion failure.
- One surface must be absorbent to allow the adhesive to dry properly. Two impervious surfaces cannot be bonded using this adhesive.

Disposal

Empty sausages and cartridges may be disposed via local landfill. If spilt, absorb with clay, sand or earth. Ensure wash water discharges to sewer only. Do not allow wash water to enter storm water drains. Collect and preferably allow the product to dry before disposal to landfill. Otherwise seal in properly labelled containers or drums for disposal to landfill.
