


Gun & hose cleaning




If your SabrGrip adhesive canister is to go into storage for a prolonged period (more than 2 weeks) it is highly recommended that a complete flush of the hose line is performed using our Sabre Citrus Cleaner.



STEP 1

Shut off valve and pull trigger on gun to release pressure and adhesive residue.



STEP 2

Unscrew hose and screw to the Sabre Citrus Cleaner immediately. If hose is not attached to the Sabre Citrus Cleaner canister quickly, adhesive residue will cure and block the hose rendering it unusable.



STEP 3

Open canister valve and pressure will fill the hose line with cleaning solution and leave valve open. Set aside for at least 20 minutes to allow adhesive residue to soften.



STEP 4

Shut off citrus canister valve and pull trigger on gun to empty the line to release pressure and cleaner residue. Ensure that you continue spraying until pressure has completely subsided.



STEP 5

Your gun tip may build up dried adhesive which will need to be cleaned off. Using Sabre Citrus Cleaner, spray cleaner on to the tip of the gun (A). Scrub tip with a wire brush (B) remove adhesive residue.



STEP 6

Your hose can now be stowed away along with your adhesive canister until future use.
